

0.1M Phosphate buffer – pH range 5.8 – 8.0

Prepare 0.2M solutions of $\text{Na}_2\text{HPO}_4 \cdot 12\text{H}_2\text{O}$ (71.64g/l) and $\text{NaH}_2\text{PO}_4 \cdot 2\text{H}_2\text{O}$ (31.21g/l)

Mix the volumes shown in the table and make the total volume up to 100cm³ or dissolve the masses indicated in water and make up to 100cm³
